Autumn Term Curriculum: Our Learning Journey is all about Ancient Egyptians

In English, our core text is A Time Travellers' Field notes and observations of Ancient Egypt. We will be writing in a range of styles based around this text.

Key Vocabulary—Pharaoh, Sphinx, Tutankhamen, exploration, traveller, tomb, pyramid, journey.

In maths, we will be focusing on Place Value - up to 5 digits, knowing numbers beyond 1000 and using the 4 main operations (subtracting, adding, division and multiplication).

In science, we will be learning all about electricity and states of matter.

In history, we will be exploring the life of the Ancient Egyptians.

In geography, we will looking at the 8 points of the compass, 4 and 6 figure grid references and map symbols and keys

In design and technology, we will be learning textile skills to create a book sleeve

In art, we will be block painting, using a woodblock to create layers of colours or a precise repeating pattern.

In Spanish, we are going to learn how to introduce ourselves.

In music, we will be having Dudley Performing Arts staff to learn how to play the violin.

In computing, we will be learning about coding and eSafety.

In **RE**, we will be learning about Christianity, Islam and Humanism.

In PSHE, we will be learning about families and friendships, safe relationships and how to respect ourselves and others.
