PE

Multiplication Table Check

During this term, your child will sit the government multiplication table check. This is nothing to worry about, and we have spoken about this at parent workshops, parents evening and daily with children in school. Please encourage your child to practice daily at home for 5 minutes. The check will take place between Monday 3 June and Friday 14 June.

Reading

Please ensure your child is reading as much as possible. Even if children are reading independently please ensure they are filling in their reading record. As a school, we really value reading and promote a love of reading. It is very important that children are reading regularly to enable them to develop fluency. If you are listening to your child read please try and ask them questions that allow them to show their understanding.

Summer Term Curriculum:

In **English**, our core text is The Jungle Book. We will be writing in a range of different genres based around different versions of the story.

In maths, we will be focusing on area and perimeter, money and word problems.

In science, we will be looking at animals including humans and living things and their habitats

In **history**, we will be exploring the local area and learning about the industrial revolution within the local area.

In geography, we will be learning about the rainforests.

In **design technology**, we will be focusing on mechanisms by making a sling shot car.

In art, we will completing the 'Arts Award' making a piece of fused glass.

In Spanish, we are learning to talk about birthdays and school.

In music, we will be having Dudley Performing Arts staff to learn how to play the violin.

In computing, we will be using Purple Mash to code and learning about Garageband on the iPads.

In RE, we will be learning about non-religious world views.

In **PSHE**, we will be learning about oral hygiene and dental care, changing during puberty and drugs common to everyday life.
