JUDAISM – THE COVENANT PROMISE AND THE “CHOSEN PEOPLE”

VOCABULARY	
Promise	a statement that something absolutely will happen or be done.
Abraham	Abraham was the founder of Judaism. Abrahamic religions can trace their origins back to Abraham, these are Christianity, Islam and Judaism
Descendants	one who comes from a given ancestor or ancestors.
Moses	Moses is a prophet from the Jewish religion who is believed to have led his people out of slavery. It is also believed that God gave the 10 commandments to Moses at Mount Sinai.
Covenant	An agreement between two or more groups of people
Promised land	The country known as Israel. This is the land that was promised to Abraham. It is also known as Palestine or the Holy Land. It is the birthplace of the Jewish people
Israel	This is the Promised land.
Consecrate	to dedicate to the service or worship of a deity
Anti-semitism	prejudice, discrimination, or hostility toward Jews
