VOCABULARY	
Muslim	a person who follows the religion of Islam.
Islam	a religion founded by Muhammad.
Qur'an	the sacred book of Islam that is the basis of Muslim religion. Muslims believe that Allah gave the words of the Qur'an to the prophet Muhammad. The Qur'an is written in Arabic.
Prophet	a person who predicts the future. It is believed that some prophets are speaking for God.
Abraham	Abraham was the founder of Judaism. Abrahamic religions can trace their origins back to Abraham, these are Christianity, Islam and Judaism
Jesus Christ	the teacher and prophet who founded the Christian faith. He is considered by Christians to be the son of God and the Christ or saviour. Jesus lived from about 4 B.C. to 29 A.D.
Moses	Moses is a prophet from the Jewish religion who is believed to have led his people out of slavery. It is also believed that God gave the 10 commandments to Moses at Mount Sinai.
Hadith	Muslims believe the Hadith is a trusted record of Muhammad's words and actions.
