


YEAR 4 - SPRING TERM SIGNIFICANT BELIEFS

Prophet	a person who predicts the future.
Incarnation	When someone possesses the characteristics of someone else or is
	seen as the bodily form of something e.g. God
Guru Nanak	He was the founder of the religion Sikhism. He was born 15th
	April 1469 AD.
Siddhartha Guatama	He is most commonly known as the Buddha and is the founder of
	Buddhism. He was born between 563 BC and 480 BC but people
	are unsure of the exact date.
Jesus Christ	He was a Jewish preacher who became the central figure of
	Christianity. He was born around the year 4AD.
Founder	a person who establishes something new and important, such as an
	institution, religion, or nation.
Miracle	an event that cannot be explained by the known laws of nature and
	is thought to be caused by a power not of the earth.
Belief	a strong opinion about a subject or idea
Reincarnation	the religious belief that human souls survive physical death and
	return in new bodies.
Heaven	in many religions, a place where God is and where people go after
	they die if they have been good people on earth.
Salvation	the act of saving or the condition of being saved from sin or evil
