| Atheism | the belief that there is no God. |
| Agnosticism | one who believes it is impossible to know anything about the existence or nonexistence of God or about the essential nature of things |
| | beyond the material universe. |
| Golden Rule | The Humanist belief that people should aim to treat each other as they would like to be treated themselves. |
| Non-religious worldview | A non-religious worldview is a belief that often focus on science, living life for the moment, and pursuing personal happiness |
| Evidence | something that gives proof of or a reason to believe something. |
| Empathy | identification with or sharing of another's feelings, situation, or attitudes. |
| Responsibility | The expectation to take care of particular things or to perform certain duties. |
| Moral | having to do with what is right and what is wrong in how a person acts. |
