VOCABULARY

Atheism	the belief that there is no God.
Agnosticism	one who believes it is impossible to know anything about the existence or nonexistence of God or about the essential nature of things beyond the material universe.
Golden Rule	The Humanist belief that people should aim to treat each other as they would like to be treated themselves.
Non-religious worldview	A non-religious worldview is a belief that often focus on science, living life for the moment, and pursuing personal happiness
Evidence	something that gives proof of or a reason to believe something.
Empathy	identification with or sharing of another's feelings, situation, or attitudes.
Responsibility	The expectation to take care of particular things or to perform certain duties.
Moral	having to do with what is right and what is wrong in how a person acts.
