Pupil achievements



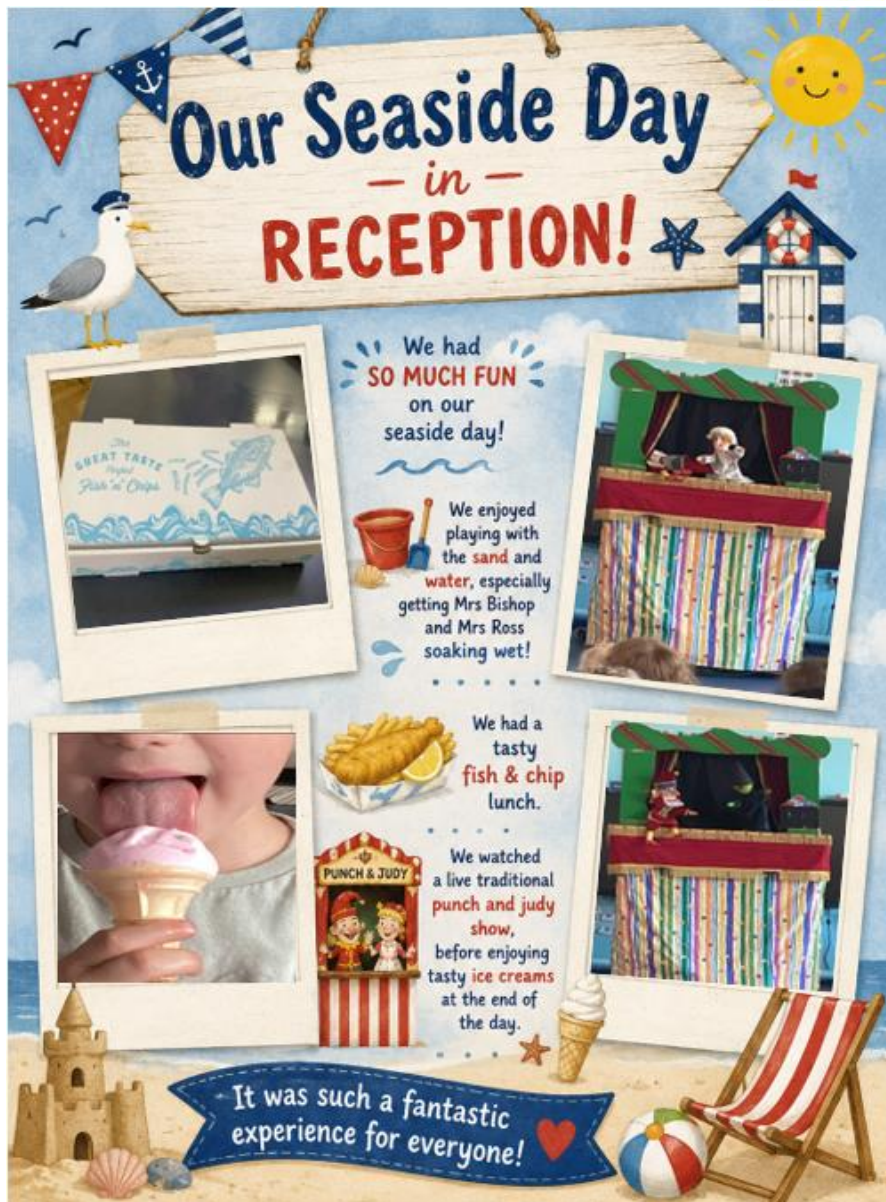
Well done to Olivia in Year 1 for achieving her medals in her gymnastics event last week!

2. Statutory assessment information (for relevant year groups only), relating to assessments completed this year:
 - o Year 1: Phonics Screening Check results
 - o Year 4: Multiplication Tables Check results
 - o Year 6 only: You may have seen in the press that national SATs results have been delayed and will not be released until Thursday 16th July.
3. Headteacher's Achievement Postcards: One child from each class will receive a Headteacher's postcard, inviting them and their family to attend our Achievers' Assembly next week. Whether you choose to keep this as a surprise or share the news with your child is entirely up to you, but either way they should be extremely proud of their achievement. We hope you are able to join us in celebrating their success.
