Draw the continent outline and research the countries within. Can you compare the country continents where Aladdin and Lion King are set- what are the similarities/differences?</p>	<p>Which country/continent is this movie set in? Belle lives in a small town, what services are available in this town? How are these services different to what you have in your town? How are they similar? Can you draw a map of your local town? Use google Earth to help you.</p>	<p>Ariel lives in the ocean however is fascinated with land and eventually brings both communities together. Draw a world map of all the oceans/seas. Plot a route for Prince Eric to travel along travelling from England to Atlantica (Ariel's home). Design and draw a comic strip showing the food chain for the same animal.</p>	<p>Plants The rose is an essential part to the movie. What are the different parts of a flower? Can you label each one? Have a go at drawing one and label each part. How do they reproduce? What do plants need to stay alive?</p>	<p>Materials and Properties Materials have different properties and purposes. What would the best material be for Eric's ship? Experiment using different materials.</p>	<p>Forces What forces would be acting upon the magic carpet?
