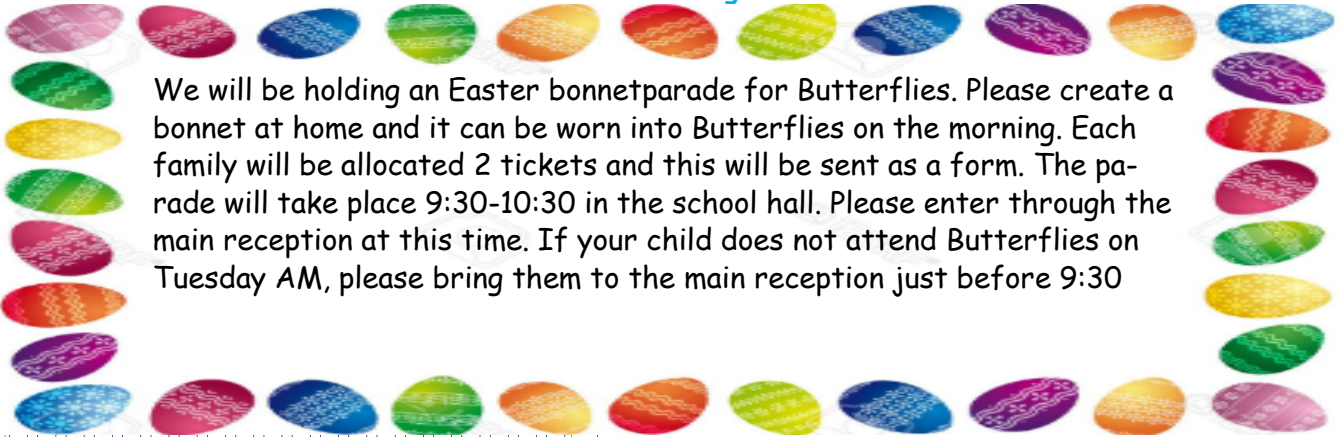
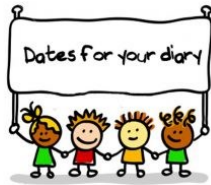


BUTTERFLIES NEWSLETTER

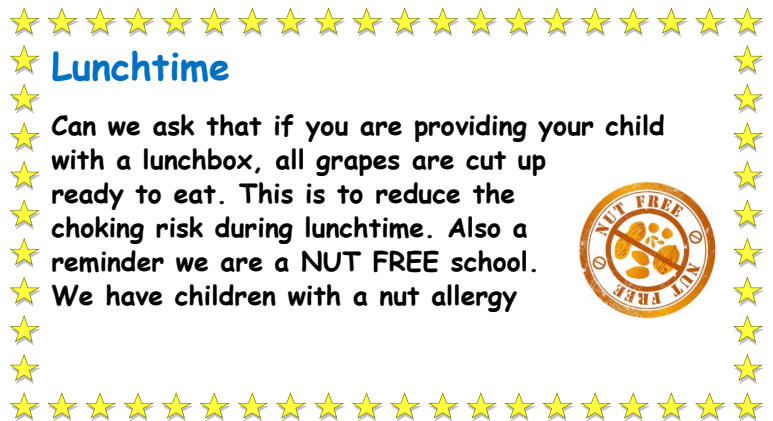
