If your child normally attends an afternoon session please bring your child to the main reception at 9:25am. The graduation will take place in the school hall and a garden picnic in the school garden. Please bring your own picnic blanket and picnic (weather permitting).

Our sports day is Monday 16th June 2025

The children who attend AM sessions will take part in the Morning Sports Day which is 10:45-11:45. Please arrive at the school field at 10:30am. Children will be dismissed from the school field.

Children who attend the PM sessions will take part in the **Afternoon Sports Day** which is 2:15-3:15. Please arrive at the school field at 2:00pm. Children will be dismissed from the school field.

Children who usually attend the full day will take part in both sessions. You are invited to come to the morning or afternoon session. Children can be taken home after the morning session. Please note that the children who are staying for lunch will be taken back to the school at 11:45.

We are dismissing from the school field so we will not be able to come back into Butteries to collect belongings so please send your child into Butterflies wearing their PE kit and a sunhat with a clearly labelled drink (lunchboxes if required).

Butterflies is open as normal but if you prefer to just attend the sports day session, please arrive at the time given above (10:30/2pm). If your child doesn't attend on a Monday, you can bring your child for any of the sessions.



Following the success of our first term of Muddy Monday we are going to make it a weekly event. If your child attends on a Monday, please send them into Butterflies with waterproof clothing for a session in the garden.

Children will be enjoying activities related to our topic each week. PLEASE bring in a pair of shoes to change into as Butterflies is becoming very muddy during lunchtime.

Lunchtime Arrangements

Payments should be made for lunchtimes in advance. We expect the supervision to be booked and paid for by the Sunday evening ready for the week ahead. If payment isn't made, we will be calling parents to come and collect their child for the 45 minute lunch period. This includes lunch bookings.
