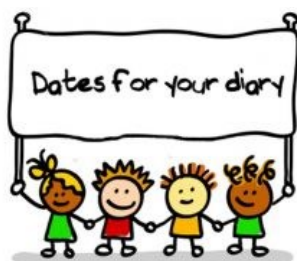

### Donations

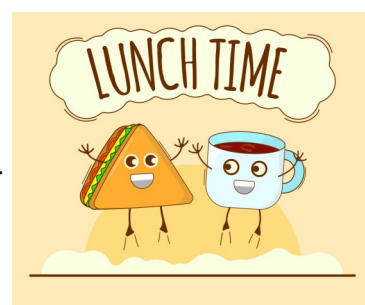
We do ask for a voluntary contribution of £1 per week so we can provide end of term parties and our fun days.
