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Let's write some poetry

Young Writers are running a competition presently for 5-11 year olds.

The theme of the competition is 'Climate Change and the World around us'

The children are asked to write a poem, which can be in any style and link to the environment from litter, pollution and wildlife, to sustainability, conservation or exploring

nature and local landscapes.

Time will be used in class, before Friday 3rd February, to introduce this competition to each class. There is a lovely video on the website to help support them, then we will share ideas before children have a go at writing their poem.

The school that submits the best overall set of entries will win The Young Writers' Award of Excellence and the class will sponsor £100 of Oxfam Unwrapped projects which positively impacts communities worldwide. PLUS a complimentary copy of the book our pupils feature in!

Every entrant receives a bookmark and we award a certificate of merit to all young writers chosen for publication.



It will run from 9am - 3:30pm and would cost £20 for 1 day, £35 for 2 days and £50 for 3 days.

At this stage we are just trying to generate interest and will only be able to run it, if we have enough interest. Young Voices 2023




Last night 31 of our pupils and 4 members of staff attended the Resorts World Arena for the Young Voices Concert and what an amazing experience it was!




The children have been working hard to learn lots of songs and dance moves, which they performed in front of thousands of people. They were also lucky enough to sing with:
