## BROOKBITES

As you are aware our kitchen is no longer owned by Dudley catering and it is our own school kitchen called Brook Bites. With the cost-of-living crisis and increase in food costs, it is essential that we work together with our families to ensure that it works well. Unfortunately, this term there has been a few issues and we are hoping you can help us with this:

Wastage- some children have ordered meals and then change their mind on the day and parents send them with a packed lunch. We really don't like throwing food away, especially in the current climate so please help us by letting us know if your child is bringing a packed lunch instead by 9am, when a hot dinner has been ordered.

Non-ordering- There have been some children who have not had meals ordered over and over again. Whilst we always try to feed these children, we can only offer a limited choice. Obviously, it is important that children have a healthy, balanced lunch so it is essential that lunches are ordered in advance (48 hours notice is preferred).
