Please encourage your child to read and share these at home with you and practise the green/red words in the book to further improve their fluency. As you may be aware, our phonics screening check will be coming up next term, so it is vital that children are practising their phonics as much as possible.

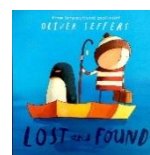
Reading
