Activity: Multi Sports Camp (Reception-Yr 6) A range of activities designed to incorporate team building games, as well as individual skill-based activities. Games will include racket games, ball games and various multi-skills and fun activities. All games are designed to improve children's confidence within a sporting environment with an emphasis on FUN at all times.

The pupils will be split into two groups of 16, a key stage 1 and key stage 2 group dependent upon numbers. There are 32 places in total. Our previous holiday camps have been extremely popular and places will be given on a first come, first served basis. Each child will receive a certificate and medal at our presentation held on the last day of Camp @ 3:00pm
