This is not only dangerous but also not showing respect, so could you please talk to your children about the importance of walking sensibly and respecting others property.

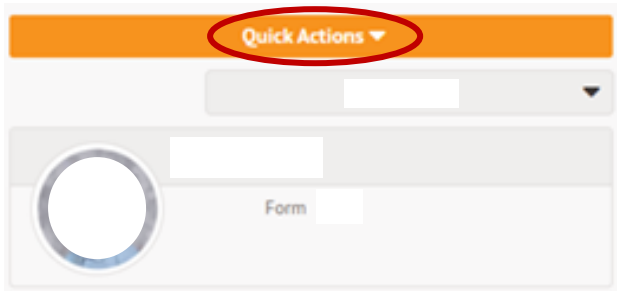


 We are noticing an increase of parents calling or turning up at school to collect children early without notice and without proof of appointments.

Please familiarise yourselves with the new system and book in advance.

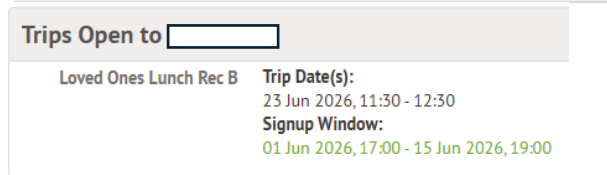


Use this drop down if you have more than 1 child at Brook to take you to each profile

Click on 'Quick Actions' and then 'trips' or 'clubs' - you will need to check both



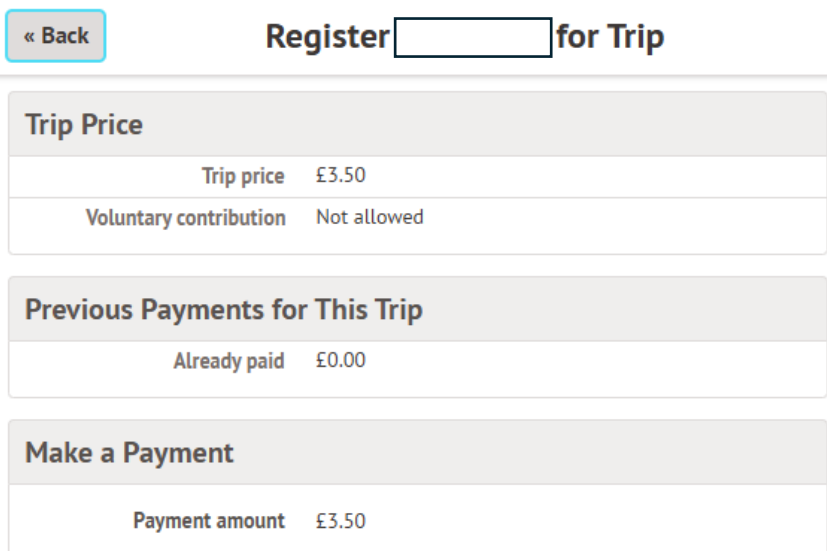
Step 2:
