Morning children can arrive between **8.45am - 9:00am** Finish at **3:20pm** 

Children will come full-time from their first day in Reception.

Access to Reception will be via the gate through Oak Park Road. This entrance is just for Reception children. There will be a member of staff waiting to greet you by the entrance. Children will be dismissed from the same door. We do ask that parents wait on the lower part of the playground to ensure staff are able to see parents and children are dismissed to the adult who is collecting them.

There will be a one-way system in place - enter through the gate near George Street and exit through the gate opposite.

We are committed to ensuring that every child feels secure, confident and excited about starting school.

We take pride in our uniform and all children need to wear school uniform at all times apart from the day they have PE.


This is a **Friday.** On this day they can arrive at school in their P.E kit.

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## Our Day

We work from the new Early Years Development Matters from September 2021
