

Welcome to Reception R Class 2025 - 2026





When I start school, I will be in Reception.

My class will be called Reception R and my teacher will be Mrs Ross.



My class teaching assistant will be Mrs Jewkes.



When I come into school, I will come in through the door in the outdoor area. I will also go out of this door at the end of the day. My adults will be there to collect me.



My new classroom looks like this.



I will have a peg in the corridor to hang my coat and bag. My adults at home will label all my things.



There is a trolley in the corridor for lunchboxes and water bottles.



In my classroom, I will see a visual timetable that will help me know what I am doing every day.



The toilets are at the end of the corridor in Reception.

I will tell an adult when I need to go to the toilet, but my teachers will make sure we all go to the toilet at snack times, break times and lunchtimes.





I will wash my hands once I have been to the toilet.

I know I should not play in the toilets.

At breaktimes and lunchtimes, I will be allowed to play outside if it is not raining.



I will ask an adult to come inside, if I need to use the toilet at breaktime or lunchtime and get a toilet pass.



Sometimes I will be allowed to play on the equipment. My teacher will tell me when it is my turn.



If I hurt myself, I will tell an adult, and they will look after me.

At lunchtime, I will eat my lunch in the school hall with my class. I can have a packed lunch from home or a lunch from the school kitchen.



If I have a lunch from the kitchen, this will be chosen for me. My teachers will look after me at lunch time.

I will also go to the school hall for PE lessons and sometimes for assemblies.



Sometimes we may do learning on the school field or in the school garden.



If the bell rings and does not stop, this is a fire alarm. It means we must leave the school building to keep safe. The bell is loud, and it might shock me when I hear it first.



I will listen to my teacher. I will walk with my class to the school playground and line up quietly.



In school, there are also other adults that I will see.
