**There is also a tray in the classroom if I need my water bottle in the room. If I want a drink, I will ask my teacher. I can drink water in the classroom. If I finish my drink and I want some more, I will ask my teacher if I can fill my water bottle at the water fountain.**

**In my classroom, I will see other labels and pictures to help me find things and know where things go.**

**There are no toilets in the Y5 classrooms. The toilets are in the Key Stage 2 corridor.**



**I will wash my hands once I have been to the toilet.**

**I know not to hang around in the toilets.**

**I will keep the toilet environment tidy.**



**At breaktimes and lunchtimes, I will be allowed to play outside if it is not raining.**



**I will ask an adult to come inside, if I need to use the toilet at breaktime or lunchtime as I will need a toilet pass.**



**Sometimes I will be allowed to play on the equipment. My teacher will tell me when it is my turn.**



**If I hurt myself, I will tell an adult and they will look after me.**



**At lunchtime, I will eat my lunch in the school hall with my class. I can have a packed lunch from home or a lunch from the school kitchen.**



**If I have a lunch from the kitchen, this will be chosen for me.**

**My teachers will look after me at lunch time.**



**I will also go to the school hall for PE lessons and assemblies.**



**Sometimes we may do learning on the school field or in the school garden.**



**Sometimes we may visit the school library. The library is next to the school hall. I can borrow books and bring them back when I have finished them.**





If the bell rings and does not stop, this is a fire alarm. It means we must leave the school building to keep safe. The bell is loud and it might shock me when I hear it first.
