

Welcome to 4H Class 2025-2026





When I come back to school in September, I will be in Year 4.

My class will be called 4H and my teacher will be Miss Hughes.

When I come into school, I will come in through the Year 4 cloakroom door along the Key Stage 2 corridor. I will also go out of this door at the end of the day.





My adults will collect me from the playground.



My new classroom looks like this.



I will have a peg in the Year 4 cloakroom to hang my coat and bag. I do not need to bring a big bag as there is no room for it in school. My adults at home will label all my things.



There is a trolley outside my classroom for lunchboxes and water bottles.



There is also a tray in the classroom if I need my water bottle in the room.



If I want a drink, I will ask my teacher. I can drink water in the classroom. If I finish my drink and I want some more, I will ask my teacher if I can fill my water bottle at the water fountain.

In my classroom, I will have a tray where I can keep my things so they are safe and don't get lost.



In my classroom, I will see a visual timetable that will help me know what I am doing every day.



In my classroom, I will see other labels and pictures to help me find things and know where things go.





There are no toilets in the Y4 classrooms. The toilets are in the Key Stage 2 corridor.

I will wash my hands once I have been to the toilet.

I know not to hang around in the toilets.

I will keep the toilet environment tidy.

At breaktimes and lunchtimes, I will be allowed to play outside if it is not raining.



I will ask an adult to come inside, if I need to use the toilet at breaktime or lunchtime as I will need a toilet pass.



Sometimes I will be allowed to play on the equipment. My teacher will tell me when it is my turn.





If I hurt myself, I will tell an adult and they will look after me.



At lunchtime, I will eat my lunch in the school hall with my class. I can have a packed lunch from home or a lunch from the school kitchen.



If I have a lunch from the kitchen, this will be chosen for me.

My teachers will look after me at lunch time.



I will also go to the school hall for PE lessons and assemblies.



Sometimes we may do learning on the school field or in the school garden.





Sometimes we may visit the school library. The library is next to the school hall. I can borrow books and bring them back when I have finished them.



If the bell rings and does not stop, this is a fire alarm. It means we must leave the school building to keep safe.

The bell is loud and it might shock me when I hear it first.



I will listen to my teacher. I will walk with my class to the school playground and line up quietly.



In school, there are also other adults that I will see.
