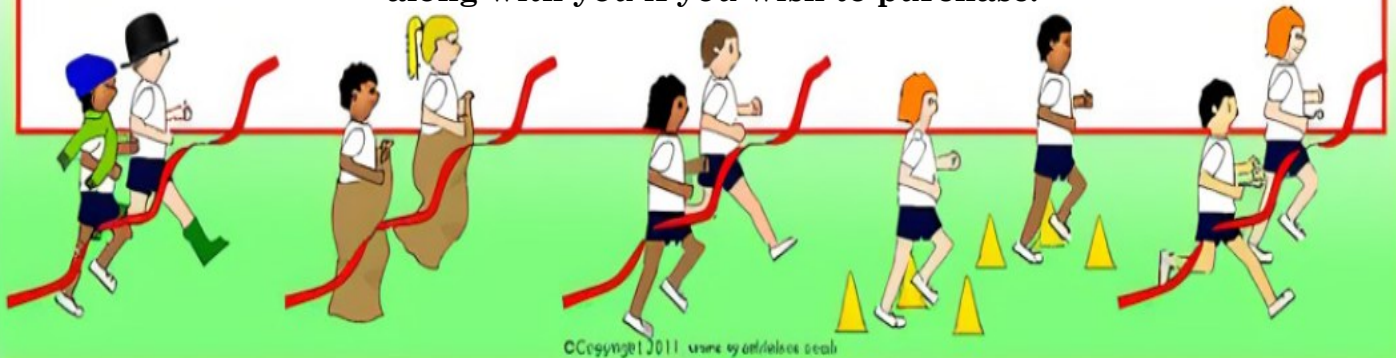

The Stourbridge Glass Museum are carrying out a competition to have your drawing turned into glass art during a live process at the museum on Saturday 23rd August!

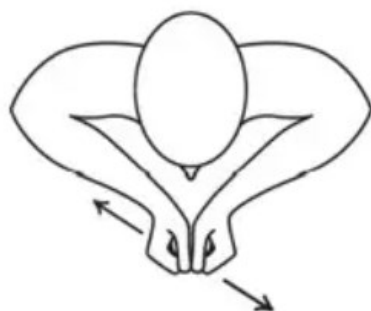
The winning piece, along with selected runners-up, will also be exhibited at Stourbridge Glass Museum before being returned to the winning school for permanent display.
