We will be celebrating 'wear it red day' on Friday 14th February to raise vital funds for the Midlands Air Ambulance service. This amazing service has responded to over 4, 500 incidents in the past year alone and saved countless lives!

We are lucky enough to have secured a visit from the air ambulance helipod on Wednesday 12th February, giving some of our children the opportunity to learn more about this service and explore what an air ambulance looks like up close. Last year our pupils at Brook really enjoyed this fantastic experience, and we are keen for more of the pupils to be offered this opportunity. There is no charge for this, but we would politely ask for as many people as possible to make a donation to the cause through the 'wear it red day' link on parentpay.

This year Reception children will visit the helipod and learn more about the air ambulance service in line with their 'People who help us' topic.

Year 2 will be visited in their classrooms by an air ambulance member of staff who will talk to them about emergencies in the home and offer some basic CPR skills as part of their PSHE curriculum.

Year 6 and butterflies will also have the opportunity to visit the helipod and learn more about the air ambulance service.



The British Science Week 2025 poster competition is open now!

The theme this year is 'Change and Adapt'! Pupils could create a poster showing how plants and animals adapt to changing seasons or surroundings, or how humans have adapted to changing technology. They could look at climate change and how we can adapt our behaviours to protect the environment, or their favourite science experiment and how it shows change.

The more creative the interpretation of the theme, the better!

Judges will be looking for a **creative approach**, clear **content** (accurate information about a STEM topic) and a poster that is presented in an **engaging** way. Entries must be one page of A4 or A3 paper and have the entrant's first name, age and class written on the back. Brook Primary can only select a maximum of five entries to be sent off. (Please note if you do not wish for pupil's name and age to be submitted to the competition then please make this clear on the entry and only the school name will be shared.)

Entries will need to be submitted to Ms Tsang by Friday 21st March.
